Approx. time required: 4-5 hours on Saturday or Sunday afternoons

Grantham Cricket Club aim to provide high-quality teas every time it's required. To do this we need volunteers who are willing to dedicate time, typically on Saturdays or Sundays, at the club. We also do barbecues at various events throughout the year. So if you'd be interested in helping with those too, please let us know.

What is required?

A cricket tea typically takes around 2 hours to prepare and 1 hour to tidy. Food is provided by the club so the main jobs are making sandwiches, cutting fruit and making pots of tea ready to serve between 3 and 4 o'clock.

Who is it for?

Grantham's senior teams are required by the league to provide a tea between innings of all their Saturday and Sunday matches.

What would I need?

A willing pair of hands is all you need to help. All cutlery, plates, mugs and food will be at the club ready as well as two dishwashers to assist with the washing up.

Summary

A typical day making a tea for the club would be something like this:

13:00 – Arrive at the club and start making sandwiches and preparing fruit

15:30 – Players finish first innings ready for food

16:00 – Players thank you and return to the game

17:00 – Finish washing up and enjoy a drink from the bar on us
