CHANGING AND SHOWERING POLICY

This policy reflects the ECB guidelines on showering and changing, published in June 2013. This policy will be made available to all parents of juniors at registration, and parents will be asked to sign to say they have read this policy. If parents have any concerns they should speak to the Club Secretary, Shelley Clayton, or Club Welfare Officer, Jo Green.

Grantham Cricket Club is committed to safeguarding the wellbeing of all young cricketers. The size of the pavilion building and the number of matches we have to accommodate means that, on occasion, we will not have a spare changing room for young cricketers. Children are under no pressure whatsoever to change at the ground before a match, and are encouraged to arrive at the ground ready to play cricket. Children are not required to shower after matches and should feel under no pressure to do so.

It is the policy of Grantham Cricket Club that adults and children should not shower or use changing facilities at the same time as children, and that mobile phones should not be used in the showering and changing facilities.

For matches and training sessions taking place at the Club's home ground at Gorse Lane:

- Adults must not change, or shower, at the same time using the same facility as children. If there is one home match, children will use a separate changing room. If there are two home matches and all changing rooms are in use, children are encouraged to arrive at the ground dressed to play cricket.
- If children play for Open Age teams, they, and their parents, must be informed of the club's policy on changing arrangements

It is the policy of Grantham Cricket Club that mixed gender teams should have separate changing facilities

- Mixed gender teams will have access to separate male and female changing rooms when the activity at the ground on match days allows this.
- If all changing rooms are in use because there are two matches at the ground, boys and girls will change at separate times.
